

New Cabinet Structure

Core Cabinet Member Requirements

- Representative of a City, School or Community Agency/Group that works with Youth and/or Families
- Decision making capacity within their community/organization
- Regular Cabinet meeting attendance
- Commitment to leveraging Cross-Sector network to support our youngest residents from cradle to career
- Monthly reporting
- Cabinet may bring in content area experts when discussing specific programs, policies and initiatives supporting the community



Cabinet Roles and Responsibilities

- 1. Align and mobilize cross-sector resources to support our youngest residents from cradle to career
- 2. Identify opportunities for advocacy at the local, state and federal level to support initiatives that align with the mission of the cabinet
- 3. Engage in collaborative budgeting to promote the shared values of the cabinet with a focus on sustainability
- 4. Discuss openly the needs of our youngest residents and accept joint responsibility to meet those needs



Youth Participation in Cabinet

- Bi-Annual Community Children's Cabinet Meeting with representation from youth-led advocacy groups
- Commitment to ensuring youth take the lead on program design, etc.







Children's Cabinet Communication
