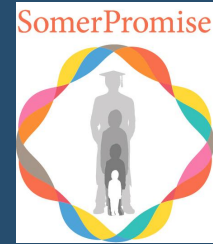

DIRECTOR OF SOMERPROMISE

The Director identifies opportunities to support children in Somerville from cradle to career. When gaps are identified, cross-sector partnerships between the City, school and community partners are formed to provide a mixed delivery system of solutions.



OUT OF SCHOOL TIME COORDINATOR

The Coordinator will support OST programs in the City of Somerville through alignment of OST Registration Support Systems, ensuring programming in summer and vacation weeks, and bridging children to youth services programming.



WRAPAROUND SERVICES MANAGER

The Wraparound Services Manager will identify barriers to accessing programming and oversee strategic programs to eliminate these barriers facilitated directly by the Navigators and Home Visitors.



CHILD CARE ACCESS COORDINATOR

The Coordinator supports our mixed delivery system of high quality early childhood education through resource sharing and collaboration with child care providers in Somerville, serving ages infancy to 5 years old.



SOMERPROMISE COORDINATOR

The SomerPromise Coordinator provides technical support on data analysis and program management. Additionally, they develop and update the City's Single Point of Entry System.

The SomerBaby Home Visitors provide educational resources, baby supplies, and referrals for new families in Somerville through a multilingual home visiting program. They also facilitate parent education groups, playgroups and support other cross-sector home visiting programs in the city.

SomerPromise Community OST Coordinator

- Target Population all children age 6-12
- Focus on OST as child care
- Coordinate Professional Development Opportunities for OST Providers
- Lead OST Provider Group
- Co-Facilitate Out of School Time Taks Force
- Lead development of City-wide Mixed Delivery Out of Schoo Time system
- Increase access to City-wide Out of School Time Programming
- Develop City-wide opportunities for OST enrollment assistance
- Lead community events to raise awareness of the importance of OST programming
- Create public events to publicize availability of OST programming
- Link OST providers with the broader network of city-wide supports
- Logistics Management to identify City owned spaces that can support OST programming
- Liase with Department of Public Health to support OST and Summer Camp licensing.

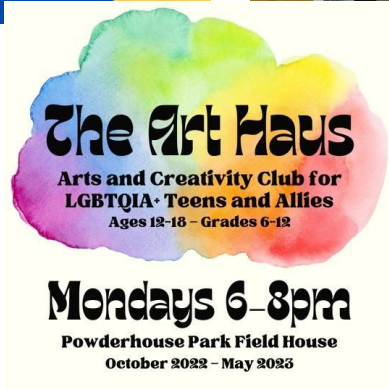
SPS Manager of OST Programs and Partnerships

- Target Population: SPS-enrolled youth K-12
- Focus on OST as enrichment opportunity
- Liase with Principals to identify programming to meet individual school needs
- Co-Facilitate Out of School Time Task Force
- Identify partners to support academic achievement
- Support Out of School Time School Clubs
- Collaborate with relevant partners to identify students that would benefit from OST programming
- Logistics Management of school spaces in OST time
- Provides operational oversight to OST school partners
- Ensure SPS OST providers are aware of and adhere to district operational, safety, and other protocols and procedures

New Cabinet Structure

Core Cabinet Member Requirements

- Representative of a City, School or Community Agency/Group that works with Youth and/or Families
- Decision making capacity within their community/organization
- Regular Cabinet meeting attendance
- Commitment to leveraging Cross-Sector network to support our youngest residents from cradle to career
- Monthly reporting
- Cabinet may bring in content area experts when discussing specific programs, policies and initiatives supporting the community

Cabinet Roles and Responsibilities

1. Align and mobilize cross-sector resources to support our youngest residents from cradle to career
2. Identify opportunities for advocacy at the local, state and federal level to support initiatives that align with the mission of the cabinet
3. Engage in collaborative budgeting to promote the shared values of the cabinet with a focus on sustainability
4. Discuss openly the needs of our youngest residents and accept joint responsibility to meet those needs

Youth Participation in Cabinet

- Bi-Annual Community Children's Cabinet Meeting with representation from youth-led advocacy groups
- Commitment to ensuring youth take the lead on program design, etc.



Children's Cabinet Communication

- Google drive with meeting notes, agendas, etc. for easy review of information and follow up tracking
- Social Media Campaign to let the community know about the Children's Cabinet and how to bring concerns/ideas to the Cabinet
- Online Monthly reports from Cabinet members to share information, updates etc.
- Data dashboard to show tracking metrics and reports, etc. to assist in the development of programs and initiatives
